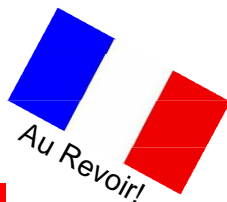

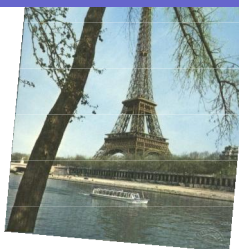

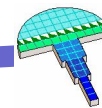

Who are we? Where are we?



The Technical High School for Tourism “Giuseppe Mazzotti” is in Treviso, at 1 Tronconi Street, which is the street for Santa Bona Vecchia, in the Repubblica Avenue zone (Ovest street), near the Communal Swimming pool (see the map).

What do we teach? What are the work possibilities after qualifying from this school?

All the study courses in our school take place over five years, and you can choose from:

Diploma in Tourism studies, with three courses: 1. (Autonomy) Tourism, 2. Iter, 3. (Traditional) Tourism. These courses give you good job possibilities after high school, such as working as an interpreter, tourist group leader, guide, hostess or steward at an airport or fairs and congresses, such as a tour operator and assistants in travel agencies, hotels etc.

With the course (Autonomy) Marketing and communication you receive a diploma as a business expert and correspondent in foreign languages. This course gives you good job possibilities after high school, in the: commercial offices, administration, search and data selection, import-export, marketing, and advertising and communication in Italy and other foreign countries.

How is our school organized?

The students attend lessons, from Monday to Saturday, the lessons begin at 7.55am and they finish at 13.05pm. In the afternoon, the students can do many activities to help with their studies such as Italian courses for foreign students (first or second level), study skills, to improve abilities in several subjects,

many activities (extracurricular), such as courses to become: hostess and congressional guide, other foreign languages, theatre, and tennis and volleyball in the gym.

Language stays and trips.

All the students in our school do a study/stay abroad in a foreign country in the third and fourth year. These last for two weeks each and help to deepen the understanding of the languages and cultures studied.

The fifth year students go on work placement in Italy or abroad for three weeks in stages. They get job experience in companies, tourist agencies or hotels, to practise what they have learned over their five years at Mazzotti.

At the end of the 5 years, the students have good job possibilities in tourism, companies and in the foreign commerce. More than half of our students decide to continue to study and they attend University with success in the faculty of Foreign Languages, Economy, Finance, Law, International Law, Marketing and Public Relations.

How do you enrol?

The parents must compile their child's information on the forms given to them by the "Scuola Media", or our secretary gives parents the forms, and then collects the information.

Moreover, they must present the following documents:

1 photo;
tax identification number;
family auto certification;
records of previous school years;
legal documentation such as Visa's and citizenship.

What subjects do our students learn?

Italian;
History;
Art History;
English;
Two foreign languages that you choose from: German, French, Spanish, Russian;
Law and Economy;
Computer science;
Tourist and Business studies;
The Geography of Tourism;
Mathematics;
Science and Biology;
Chemistry and Physics;
Physical Education;
Marketing;
Communication.

How do we teach your children to speak Italian?

We organize free Italian courses, in small groups for all students who do not know the language, or know very little. In the course of the year the course is intensified and teaches the students the various disciplines to study.

How do the teachers evaluate your progress?

Every scholastic year is divided into two semesters, one goes from September to December, the second one from January to June. At the end of every term teachers evaluate how much the students have learned and results are expressed in numbers from 1 to 10.

What is the school calendar?

Lessons are carried out from September to June. There are 2 periods of vacations: a 2 week Christmas break, then 1 week for Easter. There is a personal booklet for every student that justifies absences with parents signatures, and gives the school information.

What purpose do the meetings between parents and teachers serve?

Teachers meet parents to tell them about the progress of their children. Parents can meet the school headmaster or his collaborators by appointment. For parents who can't come in the morning, there are two general meetings with the teachers in the afternoon (the first one in December, the second in April).

How does the school receive other information?

From the Secretary of the school; from the Headmaster and from the three Collaborators; from teaching in the school, in particular the teachers who know the languages: English, French, German, Russian, Spanish, Serb-Croatian etc; from senior mother-tongue students (Chinese, Arabic etc.) We are at your disposition to give you information, counselling and aid when your children attend our school.
